DUTIES OF A MARKER

Section 14 - Law 55

The Marker shall:

- (i) Centre the Jack and place a full length Jack 2m from the front ditch in compliance with Law 22.2.
- (ii) Ensure that the Jack is a minimum of 23m from the mat line after it has been centred.
- (iii) Stand to one side of the rink and at least 2m to the rear of the Jack.
- (iv) Answer any specific question relating to the existing state of the head while the player is in possession of the rink, and when requested, clearly indicate the shot if possible.
- (v) Mark all 'touchers' immediately they come to rest, and remove chalk marks from 'non-touchers'. With the agreement of both Opponents, the Marker shall remove all 'dead bowls' from the green and ditch. The marker shall mark the positions of the Jack and 'touchers' which are in the ditch (See Law 24.4 and 29.2).
- (vi) Protect the head from any disturbance by outside objects.
- (vii) Not move, or cause to be moved, either Jack or bowls until each player has agreed to the number of shots.
- (viii) Measure carefully all doubtful shots when requested by either player. If unable to come to a decision satisfactory to the players, the Marker shall call in an Umpire whose decision shall be final.
- (ix) The marker shall enter the score at each end, and shall intimate to the players, the state of the game. When the game is finished, the Marker shall see that the scorecard containing the names of the Opponents is signed by them and disposed of in accordance with the rules of the competition.
- (x) The Marker shall remove the mat from the previous end if necessary.

CLUB BY-LAWS

Etiquette:

- ♦ Bowling bags are not to be left in the lounge entrance foyer.
- ♦ Members are reminded that the Club's insurance does not cover private property.
- ♦ Do not leave money, wallets etc in jackets hanging in the foyer or passageways.
- ♦ When a non-member is invited into the club by a member, the visitors book must be signed. This is a strict requirement of the Club Licence. The non-member should be introduced to the President or the senior members of the Executive present.
- ♦ The last person to leave the Clubhouse must ensure that all lights and heaters are turned off and that all doors and windows are securely locked.

Care of the Green

- ♦ Do not walk diagonally or unnecessarily on the greens.
- ♦ Bowling bags or other items of equipment should not be placed on the green.
- ♦ Bowling bags, score boards and other equipment should not be carried across the green. This is to ensure that nothing is dropped that could cause damage to the green.
- ♦ Members are reminded that the greens are very soft at the beginning of the season and are asked to make every effort **NOT TO DUMP** their bowls or dig their heels into the greens.

- ◆ These actions can cause a great deal of damage. Persistent “Dumpers” can be banned from playing until such time as the greens “harden up”.
- ◆ During the early part of the season Leads and Twos should stand on the bank after playing their bowls and all bowls should be carefully kicked back into the ditch after each end.

Dress:

- ◆ **Club Championships and Club Trophy Events:**
All players in a team must wear the same attire.

Mufti dress is optional for all Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday roll-up days. Mufti may also be worn at all times for practice on a green that is not in use and is available.
- ◆ **Centre Events:** When playing as a team in any Centre event all players in the team must wear the same uniform.
Markers must wear club shirts & white trousers at Centre Events.

CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP

Full Members. Shall be entitled to all the playing and other privileges and advantages of full membership of the Club.

Life Members. Any full member of not less than ten years membership who has rendered outstanding service to the Club may be elected as a Life Member.

Limited Members. If any full member, through illness or other sufficient reason is unable to play bowls regularly the Executive may classify such member a Limited Member. Limited Members shall be eligible to play in all club rollups, internal mini galas, Rotary, or any such events that the Executive may from time to time permit. They are not permitted to enter into, or play in any Club Championship or tournaments outside those already specified.

Associate Members. Any full member of any other Club affiliated to Bowls NZ shall be eligible for election as an Associate Member of this Club. Associate Members shall be entitled to play on the Club's greens on such days as the Executive approves, but shall not be eligible to play in Club trophy matches or to represent or to play for the Club in outside competition.

Honorary Members. If any full member is unable, through illness or other sufficient cause, to play bowls, and such member has taken an active and prominent part in affairs of the Club, the Executive may classify such member as an Honorary Member. Honorary Members may play at the discretion of the Executive.

Social Members. Any persons not desirous of enjoying full membership status but wishing to enjoy an ongoing association with the Club shall apply in writing to the Secretary for Social Membership status. Social Members shall be entitled only to participate in social activities and shall have no bowling privileges whatsoever.

Casual Members can participate in galas held by the Club, pay the entry fee plus pay an extra fee as set by the Executive, and become a member for the period of the gala.

Format for Club Championship

All Championship games 9.00am start. The closing time for all Championships as listed in the handbook will be 4.00pm Thursday prior to play. Club Championships will mirror the Kapiti Centre conditions of play as stated on the centre web site www.bowlskapiti.coast.com

Singles 21 shots - 3 games per day * no time limit.

Pairs 18 ends—3 games per day * no time limit.

Mixed Pairs—3 games per day *

Triples—18 ends 3 games per day—2 bowls * no time limit.

Fours—16 ends 3 games per day * no time limit.

Any byes to be played in the 1st round of post section play.

Junior singles—Men and Women—21 shots.

- ◆ **With the possibility of a fourth round to be played after consultation with players.**

Format and playing conditions to be determined prior to commencement of play, by the number of entries.

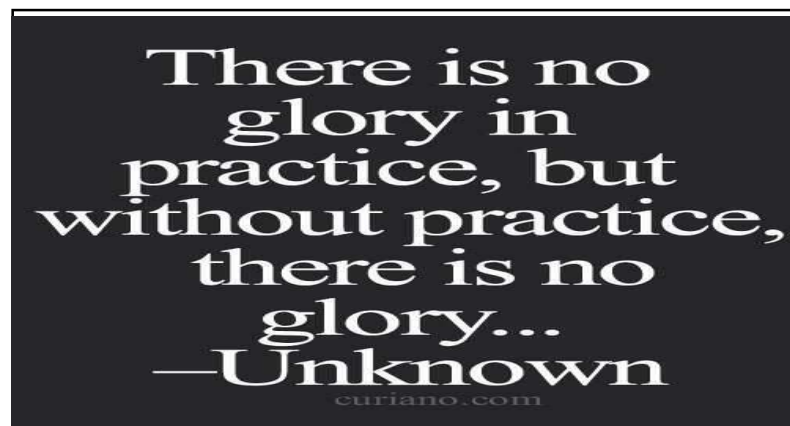
