The South Island Bowls seminar was held on the 14th & 15th August at the Southern Cross Hotel, Dunedin. This was again well attended with 97 greenkeepers and tradespeople during the 2 days.

The two guest speakers on the first day had excellent presentations and were very well received as noted by the length of the Q & A session after their presentations. The Guest speakers and their topics were:
